
Directions to Cliffside

If you use Sat-Nav, use the postcode PL10 1JS. This will get you within 100m.

From the M5:

Option 1 - Going over the Tamar Bridge (quickest)

- 1. Follow the M5 until it becomes the A38. Follow the A38 through Plymouth. Go over the Bridge into Cornwall. Through the Saltash Tunnel & for another 6 miles on the A38.
- At the Trerulefoot roundabout, take the 1st exit A374 (signposted Torpoint)
- 3. Follow A374 for 4 miles.
- 4. Take a RIGHT B3247 signposted Millbrook.
- 5. Follow B3247 through Crafthole Village stay on the B3247 (Left at mini-roundabout)
- 6. Follow B3247 for 2 miles, till you see a signpost for Whitsand Bay You can now see the sea on your right hand side.



Option 2 - Going over the Tamar Ferry (more fun if you fancy a short ferry crossing)

- 1. Follow the M5 until it becomes the A38. Follow the A38 into Plymouth
- 2. Take the A386 signposted Torpoint.
- 3. Follow the signs for Torpoint (A374) (Ignore any ferry signs these signs are for the main ferry port to France & Spain) -
- 4. You will arrive at the Torpoint Ferry which will take you into Cornwall (Every 15 mins)
- 5. Once in Cornwall, follow the A374 for 3 miles.
- 6. Turn LEFT at Antony onto B3247 (Carew Arms Pub) sign-posted Millbrook. Drive 1 mile.
- 7. Turn Left signed Whitsand Bay. Drive a 200m.
- 8. Turn Right signed Whitsand Bay You can now see the sea on your right hand side.

Finally ...

Follow the cliff road for a mile with the sea on your right. You will pass through <u>Freathy</u>. Go through Freathy, past the bus-shelter, and continue for about 300m. You will find the Parking for Cliffside on your LEFT after a 5-bar gate (the middle of 3 bays). There is a chain across the bay – it is not locked

If you look over the cliff by the car parking space, you can see Cliffside.



Then On Foot.

Walk back the way you came about 20m. You will see a footpath that leads towards the sea/beach. The path goes past a stone bench & after about 50m. there is a turn on the right leading to the property (33 steps). The key is in a key-safe by the front door. **Code** _____. The path is fairly rugged, and you will need a torch in the dark.
